AWARDS: Medals will be awarded in all events in High School divisions and all age categories; Gold, Silver, and Bronze. An awards table will be set up and once the results are official, awarded athletes can pick up their medals.

CHECK-IN: The clerk of the course is located at the end of the straightway adjacent to the door that leads to the outdoor track. Athletes in running events must check in 20 minutes before their event. Field Event athletes must check in at their respective event area 30 minutes before their events.

IMPLEMENTS: Implements will be certified in Cougar Hall, from 7:30am – 12:00 noon Sunday morning. Implements will be impounded and taken to the ring by meet officials. Only soft-shelled indoor shots may be used. Implements may be collected at the conclusion of the event.

MEET FORMAT: 60m & 60m Hurdles – The top 8 from the preliminary rounds in the High School divisions only will advance to the finals. All other track events will be run as finals on time with heats set up in the running events fastest section first. Please check the FasTrak website for information on heats and seeding and plan travel accordingly.

PACKET PICK-UP: Packets will be available on Saturday from 2-4PM at the Yeoman Fieldhouse, University of Houston Athletics/Alumni Center 3204 Cullen Blvd., Hou., TX 77204 in the Great Hall just inside the main entrance of the facility. Skip the lines on Sunday morning and pick up wristbands, and credentials. Packets not picked up on Saturday will be available at the UH Athletics Alumni Center 1 hour prior to the first event.

PARTICIPANT ENTRY & SEATING: All personnel (athletes, coaches, managers, trainers) must enter through the south side entrance to the fieldhouse. Team camps must be set up in the Sport Court area. Team seating and outside food and drink in sport court area only.

RESULTS: A Live Results QR code will be posted throughout the building and provided prior to the meet.

RULES: High School Federation Rules Apply in the High School division and USATF Age Group rules for youth divisions.

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SPECTATOR ENTRY: Spectators must enter through the front door of the Athletics/Alumni Center. Admission is \$15 for adults and youth. Children under 3 are free but must sit in the lap of a parent or guardian and may not occupy a seat or obstruct the sight lines of other guests.

SCORING: This meet will not be scored.

SPECTATOR SEATING: Spectator seating is limited and available on a first come first served basis. Spectator re-entry is allowed but will be limited to the facility's maximum capacity. Spectators may not bring outside food into the facility and Concessions will be provided.

WARM-UP AREA: Athletes should warm up outside (either on the track or the grass field). In the event of inclement weather, athletes will be permitted to warm-up inside the field house at the discretion of the meet management. Visiting team trainers should set up in the Sport Court. SPIKES MAY NOT BE WORN ON THE SPORT COURT.
